Businesses interested in the supply chain opportunities being unlocked by enfinium Skelton Grange, the new waste-to-energy hub being developed in Leeds, are invited to attend a Meet the buyer event organised by enfinium and HZI (Hitachi Zosen Inova).

The facility will divert 410,000 tonnes of residual waste and use it to generate 49MW (gross) of renewable baseload electricity per annum. This is enough energy to power more than 100,000 UK homes and businesses.

Enabling works started on site at the end of 2021, with full construction scheduled to start later in 2022 and lasting until 2025.

This event will help businesses to find out more about the opportunities on offer to potential supply chain partners who work across Leeds and the wider Yorkshire region. It is being held by enfinium in partnership with its EPC (Engineering, Procurement and Construction) contractor HZI.

Delegates will have the opportunity to meet individually with representatives of the host companies to discuss their skills and experience, while finding out more about the project's approach to procurement.
